



CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION (C&D) WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAM

California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 11, the **California Green Building Standards Code (CGBSC)**, requires new construction and demolition projects, including additions and alterations to existing buildings, to recycle, reuse, compost and/or salvage a minimum of 65% of non-hazardous construction and demolition waste (by weight) materials generated by construction projects.

CGBC SECTIONS 4.408.1 (RESIDENTIAL) AND 5.408.1 (NON-RESIDENTIAL):

The **California Green Building Standards Code** also requires that a Construction Waste Management Plan be submitted, updated as necessary, and made available during construction for examination by the enforcing agency.

CGBC SECTIONS 4.408.2 (RESIDENTIAL) AND 5.408.1.1 (NON-RESIDENTIAL):

For all Low-Rise and High-Rise Residential Construction projects, this includes:

- All new low-rise (three stories or less) and high-rise residential construction
- Any alteration and/or addition to existing residential buildings where the addition or alteration increases the building's conditioned area, volume or size

For Nonresidential Construction, this includes:

- All New (Commercial and Industrial) Buildings
- Non-Residential building additions of 1,000 square feet or greater
- Non-Residential building alterations and improvements with a permit valuation of \$200,000 or greater

CGBC SECTIONS 301.1.1 AND 301.2:

In order to document the C&D Waste Management Plan and report accurate results for a project, please use the following forms:

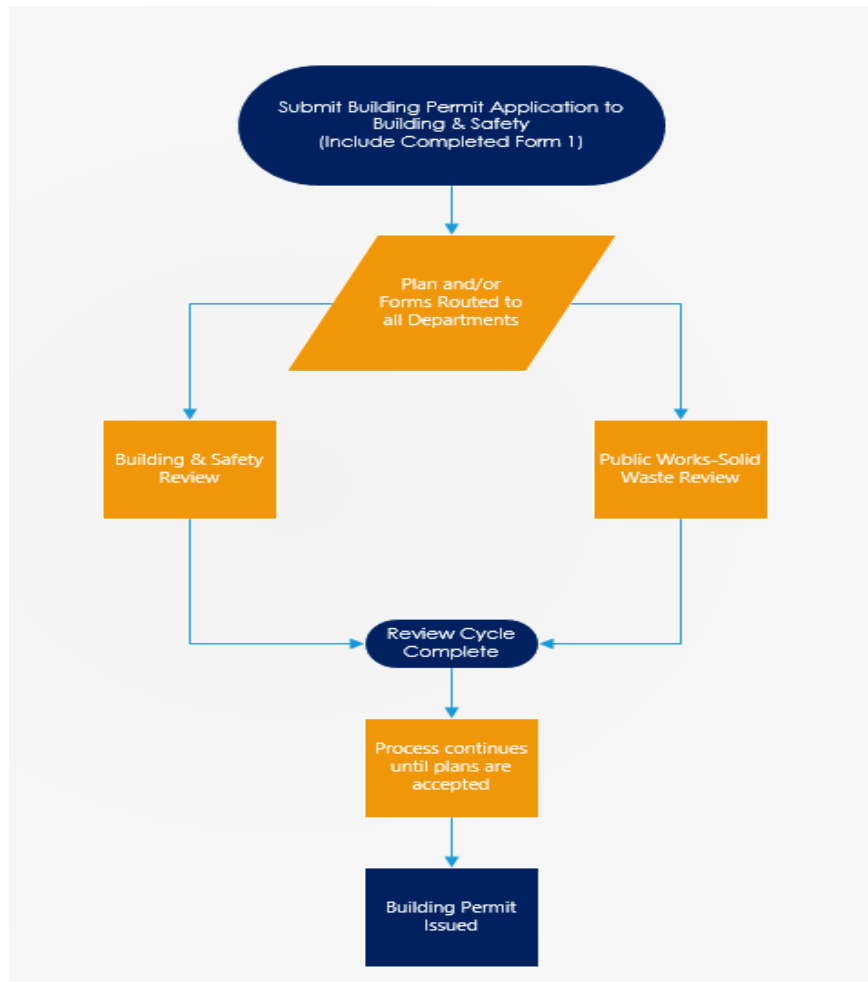
STEP 1: COMPLETE FORM 1 – WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN: THIS FORM MUST BE SUBMITTED WITH YOUR INITIAL BUILDING PERMIT APPLICATION FOR REVIEW

PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU UPLOAD A COMPLETED **C&D WASTE MANAGEMENT FORM 1** IN THE PUBLIC PERMIT PORTAL, OR IF SUBMITTING PAPER PLANS AT OUR ONE STOP SHOP COUNTER AND INSERT A COPY WITH THE PLAN CHECK DOCUMENTS.

C&D WASTE MANAGEMENT FORM 1 WILL BE ROUTED FOR REVIEW AND APPROVAL BY THE BUILDING & SAFETY AND PUBLIC WORKS-SOLID WASTE DIVISIONS PRIOR TO BUILDING PERMIT ISSUANCE.

STEP 2: COMPLETE FORM 2 – REPORTING FORM: THIS FORM SHALL BE PROVIDED TO THE PUBLIC WORKS SOLID WASTE INSPECTOR AND APPROVED BY THE SOLID WASTE DIVISION PRIOR TO FINAL BUILDING INSPECTIONS OR PROJECT APPROVALS.

REPORTING FORM 2 SHALL BE ACCOMPANIED BY ALL LETTERS, RECEIPTS AND OFFICIAL TICKETS FROM APPROVED WASTE HAULERS OR LANDFILLS INCLUDING CERTIFIED WEIGHTS FOR ALL MATERIALS AND/OR WASTE RECYCLED, AND BE SHALL RECEIVED AND APPROVED BY THE PUBLIC WORKS SOLID WASTE INSPECTOR PRIOR TO ANY BUILDING FINAL APPROVAL AND/OR CERTIFICATE OF OCCUPANCY RELEASE.
