SUBJECT: INVESTMENT SUMMARY AND FINANCIAL REPORTS - AUGUST 31, 2011

ISSUE:

The City Manager's Office prepares monthly financial reports and an investment summary for City Council review.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

That the City Council receive and file these reports.

BACKGROUND:

Sound investment practices are essential to good fiscal management. The Assistant City Manager/CFO/Treasurer is responsible for managing the City's investment portfolio. Cash flow is monitored on a daily basis and unexpended cash is directed towards investments that exhibit first safety, then liquidity and an appropriate return on investment. The investment results are summarized and reported to the City Council at each month-end.

Sound management practices include monitoring revenue and expenditures against the City Council approved budget. Financial reporting is suspended pending the closing of the accounts for the fiscal year and completion of the independent audit.



It has been verified that this investment portfolio is in conformity, exclusive of items identified, with the City of Riverside's investment policy which was approved by City Council on March 01, 2011. The Treasurer's cash management program and cash flow analysis indicates that sufficient liquidity is on hand to meet estimated future expenditures for a period of six months. The weighted average maturity of the pooled investment portfolio is 1.30 years. Market prices of securities are obtained directly through Union Bank. Weighted average yield on cost is 1.977%.
