CURRENT SITUATION

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a report of a vehicle and vegetation fire in the hills to the north of Valley Drive. The first arriving engine company reported a fire of approximately one quarter acre burning in open land to the north of Valley Drive. Access to the fire was difficult due to the terrain, but two brush units were eventually able to make access to the fire. They found a vehicle that had caught fire resulting in adjacent vegetation igniting. The fire was held to one quarter acre. The owner of the vehicle, a male in his early twenties, sustained a minor burn to his right hand. He was treated by fire department paramedics and released at the scene. There were no firefighter injuries during the incident. The cause of the fire was a mechanical failure in the vehicle.
