### CURRENT SITUATION

*(Recent updates are posted at the top of Current Situation)*

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to stranded hiker on Mt. Rubidoux. It was difficult to locate the patient as she was down in a ravine and was not visible from the road due to the vegetation growth. The Riverside Police Department assisted with Air 1 to find her location. She was found about 150 feet down the hillside from the castle. Crews assembled a lowering and belay rope system to make their way to her and assessed for injuries. She did not have any signs of injury, however she appeared to show signs of dehydration. She stated she was out on MT. Rubidoux at 1100 AM. We made contact with her at approximately 1245. The temperatures were approximately 106 degrees. The City of Riverside Fire Department Technical Rescue Team established at the road above her and assisted with the efforts to rescue her from the mountain side utilizing rope rescue systems. She was successfully removed from the mountainside and transported by ambulance to a local hospital for further evaluation. There were no firefighter injuries during this incident.
