CURRENT SITUATION

(Recent updates are posted at the top of Current Situation)

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a possible structure fire. Upon arrival we found a two story single family dwelling converted to a two story apartment complex with fire showing from the front living room and porch of the second story. Crews initiated transitional fire attack. They knocked the heat out of the fire and extinguished the stairs. Afterward they transitioned to the second floor through a widow for fire attack and extinguished the blaze. The second floor occupant was not home at the time. However, the first floor occupants were home and evacuated. Both floors were searched and no occupants were inside. The first floor was salvaged and checked for fire extension. The origin was located on the porch stairwell area. The occupant arrived and advised that she smoked outside on the porch and had kept her ashtray on the corner of the stair rail. The cause and origin was in line with her statement. It appears that the fire started form a carelessly discarded cigarette. An additional engine and BS 5 was requested due to the extreme heat. The crews continued to overhaul the second floor. Red cross was requested for four adult and four children. The scene was turned over to the owner and all units cleared the scene.
