CURRENT SITUATION

On January 12th, 2018 at 3:07 p.m. The City of Riverside Fire Department responded a Technical Response to the 5941 Ordway at Quality Industry Repairs for reports of an employee trapped under a conveyor belt system that had fallen on him. Firefighters arrived to find a male patient being treated by AMR Paramedics who was freed from the machinery by on site employees of Quality Industry Repairs. The patient was in minor condition with complaints to his ankle. Fire department paramedics assisted AMR with treatment and care. The patient was transported to a local area hospital for further treatment. The accident happened as a result of a large (metal) conveyor belt system was being moved in an open storage facility when the system fell off the forks of the forklift and onto the subjects legs and feet creating the injury. CAL-OSHA was notified of the incident.
