CURRENT SITUATION

City of Riverside Firefighters responded to a 20 acre vegetation fire in the river bottom area. Fire crews contained the fire to the river bottom area and prevented any structures from being damaged. Two (2) firefighters sustained minor injuries related to heat exhaustion. One (1) firefighter was transported to Riverside Community Hospital where he was treated and released. The City of Riverside was assisted by Cal Fire/Riverside County Fire Dept., Corona and Murrieta Fire Departments. Cause of the fire is under investigation.
