CURRENT SITUATION

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a report of a fire within an occupied home on Keller Avenue. Units arrived on the scene and found a single story, single family dwelling with a moderate amount of fire and smoke showing from the front of the house. It appeared the fire involved an attached garage that had been converted to a bedroom. Firefighters quickly contained the fire to the room of origin. All occupants had escaped prior to the arrival of firefighters. None of the occupants were injured by the fire. The house was damaged extensively, both by heat and by smoke. Firefighters assisted the family in quickly removing wrapped Christmas presents and preventing any further loss by this accidental fire. Fire Investigators determined the cause of the fire to be unattended lite candles that were placed near combustible objects. The City of Riverside Fire Department reminds all resident to use caution during this Holiday season with decorative candles.
