



Regarding Street Construction Projects:

To reduce traffic congestion on arterial highways, to minimize air pollution, and the impacts to businesses, weekend or night work* may be required.

Some examples of streets with these restrictions include, *but are not limited to*:

Adams Street (Magnolia to Lincoln) Alessandro Boulevard Arlington Avenue (Adams to Alessandro) Canyon Crest Drive Central Avenue (Chicago to Route 60) Central Avenue (Magnolia to Alessandro) Chicago Avenue Day Street Fourteenth Street (MLK) (Brockton to Route 60) Magnolia Avenue Tyler Street (Indiana to Hole) University Avenue (Market to UCR) Van Buren Boulevard

Special Circumstances:

Work hours may be restricted around schools and other similar type facilities.

Traffic Control:

Generally use MUTCD or WATCH manual; however, special cases may require custom traffic control plans.

* Night work is generally Sunday through Thursday 9 p.m. – 5 a.m. (hours may vary) Weekend work is generally from Friday 9 p.m. to Monday 5 a.m. (hours may vary)
