### Riverside Police DUI Checkpoint Nets 3 Arrests

The Riverside Police Department conducted a DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint on Friday, May 27, 2011, as part of Riverside's commitment to public safety. This checkpoint was one of many that have been or will be conducted throughout the year in the city of Riverside. The location of Friday's checkpoint was on Adams Street at Briarwood Drive. The goal of the DUI Checkpoint was removing impaired drivers and to bring awareness to the public of the dangers of driving under the influence of drugs and alcohol.

In addition to enforcing traffic laws the Department's personnel assisted several families with the proper installation of their child safety seats.

1204 Vehicles Passed Through the Checkpoint  
1204 Drivers Were Screened  
3 DUI Suspects Arrested  
61 Citations Were Issued  
20 Vehicles Impounded  
25 Unlicensed and Suspended Drivers Were Sent to Court
