Armed Robbery Suspects Pursued and Arrested

Riverside, CA -- On Tuesday, June 14, 2011, at 9:10 PM the Riverside Police Department's Communication Center received a call of an armed robbery that had just occurred at the El Toro Market in the 10700 Hole Ave in Riverside. The victims described two male black adults armed with a handgun that fled on foot.

When officers arrived they learned the two suspects had run north from the location on Hedrick.

While officers were conducting an area check for the suspects, dispatch advised of another armed robbery in progress nearby at the One Stop Market in the 4500 block of La Sierra Ave. Officers arrived within seconds and found the suspects had just left in a red Nissan Altima.

Officers armed with this information checked the area and found the vehicle driving with two male blacks and one female black inside. The officer waited for assisting units and the Police Helicopter prior to attempting a stop. Once they arrived, a stop was attempted, however the vehicle fled. A 34 minute pursuit ensued, traversing the area of Lake Matthews and Mead Valley. Spike strips were deployed and the suspects eventually stopped in a gas station at Nuevo and Perris Blvd in Perris. "Each person involved in this incident from the victims, to the dispatcher to the helicopter officers, to the traffic officer that located the vehicle did an outstanding job. It was a perfect storm of excellence that culminated with three very bad career criminals taken off the street", said Lieutenant Chuck Griffiths.

Each of the suspects were identified by the victims and transported to the station for processing and interviews. They are identified as Lanae White, female, 21 years old from Los Angeles. Antwine Dozier, male, 28 years old from Los Angeles and Scyler Wilkerson, male, 26 years old from Inglewood.

Detectives from the Robbery / Homicide Unit responded to the station to assist with the investigation. Items of evidence were collected at the scene and the investigation is on-going.
