## **MAJOR INJURY TRAFFIC COLLISION**

**RIVERSIDE, CA** – On Saturday, December 31, 2016, at approximately 9:07 PM, Riverside Police and Fire responded to a report of two vehicle traffic collision at the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Jackson Street. Initial Reports show that a Red Chevrolet Silverado was traveling east on Magnolia Avenue when the driver failed to yield at a red light. The Silverado collided with a Silver Nissan Pathfinder that was driving north on Jackson Street through the intersection.

The driver and passenger of the Red Silverado were transported to Riverside Community Hospital where they were treated for their injuries. The front passenger of the truck has moderate injuries and the 21 year old male driver is currently in critical condition.

Officers from the Riverside Police Department M.A.I.T. were called to the scene and are investigating this incident.
