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It was moved by Councilman Zimmerman, seconded by Councilman Rohrer, that the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 408 (New Series)

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside, State of California, did on May 31, 1916, pass its Resolution of Intention No. 371 (New Series) to order and do certain work therein described, to-wit: the vacation, closing and abandoning of the portion of Olive Street in said resolution of intention described, and which resolution was duly and regularly published as required by law; and

Whereas, notices of said resolution as required by law were duly and regularly and legally posted in the form and manner required by law, and all protests or objections to said work were heard and disposed of in the manner required by law by the Common Council, and the Common Council having acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed work; and

Whereas, the Common Council did by its Resolution No. 394 (New Series) duly and regularly passed on August 15, 1916, order said work to be done, which resolution was duly published as required by law,

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Common Council of the City of Riverside, State of California, that that portion of Olive Street in said city between the southerly property line of Seventh Street and the northerly property line of Tenth Street, be and the same is hereby vacated, abandoned and closed.
