

RESOLUTION NO. 3054 (NEW SERIES)
DECLARING THAT THE CLOSING UP AND VACATING OF
A CERTAIN ALLEY IN ELDORADO TRACT HAS BEEN
COMPLETED

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WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 9th day of February, 1937, pass its resolution No. 3052 (New Series), ordering the work of closing up and vacating of a certain Alley in El Dorado Tract in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 3047 (New Series): and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating of that certain Alley has been done and completed;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that said Council hereby declares that that certain Alley in the El Dorado Tract in said City hereinafter described is closed and vacated.

The Alley is said City hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of the Alley lying between Lots 1 and 2 on the Southeast and Lot 28 on the Northwest of the El Dorado Tract, being all that portion of that said alley lying westerly of and parallel with Walnut Street, and extending from El Dorado Street to Thirteenth Street.
