RELEASE OF COVENANT AND AGREEMENT FOR CONSTRUCTION AND MAINTENANCE OF STORM DRAIN IMPROVEMENTS

THIS RELEASE OF COVENANT AND AGREEMENT is made and executed this 19th day of August, 1986, by and on behalf of the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS on October 2, 1979, RIVERSIDE BUSINESS CENTER, a limited partnership (hereinafter referred to as "Center") executed that certain Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements relating to the real property located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, then owned by Center, described as follows:

THENCE South 33° 46' East, 995.35 feet to the Northerly boundary line of the right-of-way of the Southern Pacific Railway Company through said Block 46; THENCE South 67° 48' West, on said boundary line, 1743.3 feet to the Easterly boundary line of Pierce

THENCE North 33° 46' West, on the Easterly line of Pierce Street, 647.25 feet to the Southerly boundary line of Magnolia Avenue;

THENCE North 56° 14' East, on the Southerly boundary line of Magnolia Avenue, 1708.1 feet to the point of beginning;

EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion conveyed to the State of California by deed recorded February 25, 1958 as Instrument No. 13766 of Official Records of Riverside County, California,

hereinafter referred to as the "Property"; and

WHEREAS said Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements was recorded December 7, 1979 as Instrument No. 261267 of Official Records of Riverside County, California; and

WHEREAS in said Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements, the Center, for the purpose of complying with one of the conditions imposed by the City of Riverside, California, of Parcel Map 12957, agreed to accept on the above-described Property the local drainage from that portion of Magnolia Avenue easterly of Pierce Street, to construct seepage pits on Parcel 1 of said Parcel Map 12957 of sufficient size to dispose of drainage of approximately ten gallons per minute, and to maintain or to make adequate provisions for the proper maintenance of the seepage pits and appurtenant structures until a permanent storm drain system is constructed on Magnolia Avenue and Pierce Street of such size as to control aid Magnolia Avenue drainage; and

WHEREAS the City of Riverside has caused to be constructed and accepted a storm drain into which the local drainage now flows, thereby allowing the release of the Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements dated October 2, 1979; and

WHEREAS the Property previously owned by Center and which is encumbered by the Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements dated October 2, 1979 is now owned by DAVID G. NANCARROW, a married man, and LINCOLN RIVERSIDE BUSINESS CENTER, a California limited partnership;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, by action duly taken at its regular meeting on August 19, 1986, has determined that the owners of the above-described Property no longer need to maintain or to make adequate provisions for the maintenance of the seepage pits and appurtenant structures as a permanent storm drain has been constructed on Magnolia Avenue and Pierce Street of such size as to control the Magnolia Avenue drainage adjacent to the abovedescribed property. Therefore, the City Council on behalf of the City of Riverside hereby releases the Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements dated October 2, 1979, and recorded December 7, 1979 as Instrument No. 261267 of Official Records of Riverside County, California and hereby discharges DAVID G. NANCARROW and LINCOLN RIVERSIDE BUSINESS CENTER, their heirs, successors and assigns, as to the Property above described from any obligation or duty set forth in the Covenant and Agreement for Construction and Maintenance of Storm Drain Improvements dated October 2, 1979.
