RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A DEED.

RESOLVED, that that certain deed dated April 16, 1940, from
Lucy W. Bennett, granting to the City of Riverside, a municipal
corporation, all the following described property situate in the
City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California,
to-wit:

Commencing at a point in the Southerly line of Eighth
Street, 25 feet Easterly from the Northwesterly corner
of Block 8, Range 2, as shown by Map of the CITY OF
RIVERSIDE, recorded in Book 7 page 17 of Maps, records
of San Bernardino County, California;

Thence Southerly and parallel with the Easterly line of
Mulberry Street, 132 feet;

Thence Easterly at right angles and parallel with the
Southerly line of Eighth Street, 50 feet;

Thence Northerly at right angles and parallel with the
easterly line of Mulberry Street, 132 feet to the
Southerly line of Eighth Street;

Thence Westerly along the Southerly line of Eighth Street,
50 feet to the point of beginning.
