

I, Elizabeth M. Cox, of Riverside, California, hereby grant to the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation of the Sixth Class organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, a right of way for a public sewer over and across those certain lots or parcels of land situate, lying and being in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and particularly described as follows, to-wit: x Lots numbered Two, Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7) and Eight (8) in Block Four (4) and Lots Ten (10), Eleven (11) and Twenty-nine (29) of Block Three (3) all in Cox's Addition to Riverside, according to map and survey thereof of record in the County Recorder's office of San Bernardino County, California; beginning at a point on the Northerly boundary line of said Lot Two (2) in Block Four (4) aforesaid, distant two feet Westerly from the Easterly boundary line of said Lot Two (2), and running thence Southerly parallel with the Easterly boundary line of said Lot Two (2) to a point two (2) feet Northerly from the Southerly boundary line of said Lot Two; thence at a right angle Easterly, parallel with Tenth street to a point on the Easterly boundary line of said Lot Eight (8) in Block Four (4) aforesaid, two (2) feet Northerly from the Southerly boundary line of said Lot Eight (8); also beginning at a point on the Westerly boundary line of said Lot Ten (10) in Block Three aforesaid, distant two feet Northerly from the Southerly boundary line of said Lot Ten (10) and running thence Easterly, parallel to Tenth street to a point two (2) feet Easterly from the Westerly boundary line of said Lot Eleven (11) in Block Three (3) aforesaid, and running thence Southerly parallel with the Westerly boundary line of said Lot Twenty-nine (29) to a point on the Northerly line of Eleventh street distant two feet Easterly from the Westerly boundary line of said Lot 29.
