

SEWER R/W ACROSS LOT 10, BLK. 4 COX ADD. 281

I, Rachel Lathrop, of Riverside, California, hereby grant to the City of Riverside, a Municipal corporation of the Sixth Class organized and existing under the laws of the State of California, a right of way for a public sewer over and across that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and bounded and described as follows, to-wit: Lot Ten (10) in Block Four (4) of Cox's Addition to Riverside, according to Map and survey thereof of record in the County Recorder's office of San Bernardino County, California; beginning at a point on the Easterly boundary line of said Lot Ten (10) distant Two (2) feet Northerly from the Southerly boundary line thereof, and running thence Westerly parallel with the Southerly boundary line of said Lot Ten to the Westerly boundary line of said Lot.
