Commencing at the northeast corner of Lot 13, Block 1, of the Tibbetts Tract as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 2 at page 35 of Records of San Bernardino County, thence northerly along the northerly prolongation of the easterly line of said Lot 13, a distance of fifteen feet (15') to a point in the northerly line of that portion of Tibbetts Avenue vacated by Ordinance No. 262 of the City of Riverside, lying northerly of said Lot 13, thence westerly along said northerly line a distance of thirteen and two hundredths feet (13.02') to the true point of beginning of this description; thence continuing westerly along said northerly line a distance of one hundred twenty-nine and fifty-four hundredths feet (129.54') to its intersection with the southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue, a public street in the City of Riverside, one hundred feet (100') wide, thence northeasterly along the southeasterly line of said Magnolia Avenue a distance of thirty-three and ninety-two hundredths feet (33.92') thence southeasterly at a right angle to the last mentioned line a distance of five feet (5') thence southeasterly along a curve concave to the northeast having a central angle of 28° 18' 10" and a radius of two hundred thirty feet (230') a distance of one hundred thirteen and sixty-one hundredths feet (113.61') to the true point of beginning.
