RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CHANGING THE NAME OF RAILROAD AVENUE TO SAUNDERS STREET.

WHEREAS, there was filed with the City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, a recommendation by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside that the name of Railroad Avenue be changed to Saunders Street, said street being more particularly described as follows:

Railroad Avenue between Prospect Avenue and Roma Street, now abandoned, and as shown by map of Prospect Place, recorded in Book 5 of Maps at page 88, Records of San Bernardino County, California.

WHEREAS, it is to the best interest of the City that the name of Railroad Avenue be changed to Saunders Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in consideration of the facts as hereinabove set forth the name of Railroad Avenue, said street being hereinabove described, be, and the same is hereby, changed to "SAUNDERS STREET" and said street shall hereafter be known as Saunders Street.
