legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary 24

for present or prospective public use. 25

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the sewer easement in Lots 248 and 248-A of Lands of Southern California Colony Association, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, 2 sted
