

2	RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING	
3	A PUTLIC UTILITY EASEMENT IN LOT 495 OF SUN GOLD TERRACE UNIT NO. 7.

5	WHEREAS, on the 8th day of December, 1953, Ordinance No. 2008	
6	of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the	
7	intention of the City Council to vacate a public utility easement	
8	in Lot 495 of Sun Gold Terrace Unit No. 7, pursuant to the pro-	
9	visions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,	
10	WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for	
11	Tuesday, February 2, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council	
12	Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,	
13	Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons	
14	interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed	
15	to be heard; and,	
16	WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section	
17	50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,	
18	WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had	
19	before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at	
20	which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard	
21	by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all	
22	of the evidence submitted that the public utility easement which	
23	the legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unneces-	
24	sary for present or prospective public use.	
25	NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the	
26	City of Riverside, California, that the public utility easement	
27	in Lot 495 of Sun Gold Terrace Unit No. 7, in the City of Riverside	Э,
28	County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:	:
29	The southerly five feet (5') of Lot 495, of Sun Gold Terrace, Unit No. 7, shown on a map	
80	recorded in Map Book 26, at page 49, Records of Riverside County; EXCEPT the easterly five	
81	feet (5') thereof;
