RESOLUTION NO. 6236

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PEDESTRIAN WALKS IN LA HACIENDA RANCHO TRACT AND IN ARLINGTON PALMS, AND PORTIONS OF THE PEDESTRIAN WALKS IN SYDENSTRICKER TRACT.

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6 WHEREAS, on the 20th day of April, 1954, Ordinance No. 2066  
7 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the  
8 intention of the City Council to vacate the pedestrian walks in  
9 La Hacienda Rancho Tract and in Arlington Palms, and portions of  
10 the pedestrian walks in Sydenstricker Tract, pursuant to the  
11 provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

12 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for  
13 Tuesday, June 15, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council  
14 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,  
15 Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons  
16 interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed  
17 to be heard; and,

18 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section  
19 50331 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

20 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had  
21 before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at  
22 which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard  
23 by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all  
24 of the evidence submitted that the pedestrian walks in La Hacienda  
25 Rancho Tract and in Arlington Palms, and the portions of the  
26 pedestrian walks in Sydenstricker Tract which the legislative  
27 body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present  
28 or prospective public use.

29 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the  
30 City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian walks in La  
31 Hacienda Rancho Tract and in Arlington Palms, and the portions  
32 of the pedestrian walks in Sydenstricker Tract, all in the City

1 of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and  
2 described as follows:

3 Lots B and C of La Hacienda Rancho Tract, as  
4 recorded in Book 26 of Maps, page 17, Records  
5 of Riverside County, California; EXCEPTING  
6 THEREFROM any existing public utility easements  
7 of record over, along or across said lots.

8 Lots H, I, J and K of Arlington Palms, as  
9 recorded in Book 25 of Maps, pages 78 and 79,  
10 Records of Riverside County, California;  
11 EXCEPTING THEREFROM any existing public utility  
12 easements of record over, along or across said  
13 lots.

14 The southeasterly 7.5 feet of Lot B, except the  
15 southwesterly 10 feet thereof; and  
16 The northwesterly 7.5 feet of Lot B, except the  
17 southwesterly 10 feet thereof; and  
18 The southeasterly 7.5 feet of Lot C, except the  
19 northeasterly 10 feet thereof; and  
20 The northwesterly 7.5 feet of Lot C, except the  
21 northeasterly 10 feet thereof;  
22 All in Sydenstricker Tract, as recorded in Book 21  
23 of Maps, page 95, Records of Riverside County,  
24 California; EXCEPTING THEREFROM any existing public  
25 utility easements of record over, along or across  
26 said lots;


27 are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the  
28 same be and are hereby vacated.

29 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy  
30 of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the  
31 Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

attested by the City Clerk this 15th day of June, 1954.


