WHEREAS, on the 26th day of October, 1954, Ordinance No. 2127 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate portions of public utility essements over Lots 1 to 7, inclusive, and over Lot 9 of Crowell Osmichas, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation law: and.

WHEREFS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for 11 Tuesday, December 21, 1954, at 10 e'clock A. M. in the Council 12 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, 13 Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons 14 interested in or objecting to the proposed vacations be allowed 15 to be heard; and, 16

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAR, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the portions of public utility easements which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of the public utility easements over Lots 1 to 7, inclusive, and over lot 3 of Crowell Gardens, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

The southwesterly five feet (5') of the north-easterly ten feet (10') of Lots 1 to 7, inclusive, and of Lot 9, of Crowell Cardens, shown on a map
