RESOLUTION NO. 6538

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING
PORTIONS OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT OVER LOTS
12, 13, 20, 21, AND 23 OF COLE TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of December, 1954, Ordinance No. 2150 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate portions of the public utility easement over Lots 12, 13, 20, 21, and 23, Cole Tract, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, February 8, 1955, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the portions of the public utility easement which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of the public utility easement over Lots 12, 13, 20, 21, and 23 of Cole Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

The westerly ten feet (10') of the northerly ninety-six feet (96') of Lots 20 and 23 of the

1 Cole Tract, as shown on a map recorded in Map
Book 27 at page 25, Records of Riverside County;

2 Also the westerly ten feet (10') of the southerly
3 ninety-six feet (96') of Lots 13 and 21 of said
Cole Tract;

4 Also the westerly ten feet (10') of the northerly
5 ninety-eight and seventy-six hundredths feet (98.76')
6 of Lot 12 of said Cole Tract;

7 are unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that
8 the same be and are hereby vacated.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy
10 of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the
11 Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

12 ADOPTED by the City Council, signed by the Mayor, and
13 attested by the City Clerk this 6th day of February, 1955.
