A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PORTIONS OF PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT OVER LOTS 1 TO 8, INCLUSIVE, AND LOTS 8 TO 17, INCLUSIVE, GREENBRIAR TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 27th day of September, 1955, Ordinance No. 2259 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate portions of public utility easement over portions of Lots 1 to 8, inclusive, and Lots 8 to 17, inclusive, Greenbriar Tract, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

 Lots 8 to 17, inclusive;
