

RESOLUTION NO. 7728

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF A STORM DRAIN EASEMENT OVER A PORTION OF LOT 9 OF RIVERA TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of March, 1957, Ordinance No. 2492 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate a portion of a storm drain easement over a portion of Lot 9 of Rivera Tract, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said Ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, May 14, 1957, at 10:00 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 65451 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of the storm drain easement which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of the storm drain easement over a portion of Lot 9 of Rivera Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

A portion of Lot 9 of the Rivera Tract, as per map recorded in Book 10, page 4 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California; more particularly described as that portion of a storm drain right of way as conveyed by H. Page Bailey and Nell Bailey,

1 his wife, to the City of Riverside by Deed recorded
2 in Book 498, page 372, Official Records, Riverside
County, California;

3 EXCEPTING THEREFROM that portion included in
4 Crestmore Avenue, and that portion included within that
5 parcel of land as conveyed to the City of Riverside by
Deed recorded in Book 1530, page 68, Official Records,
Riverside County, California;

6 is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that
7 the same be and is hereby vacated.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk cause a certified
9 copy of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded
10 in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County,
11 California.
