Said NWly 10 ft, being further described as that 10 ft. strip of land lying NWly of and adjoining that certain 25 ft. strip of land deeded to the City of Riverside for highway purposes, by deed recorded in Book 147, pages 98 and 100 of Deeds, in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County.


