FINAL ORDER OF

CONDEMNATION.

It satisfactorily appearing to the Court that the plaintiff in the above-entitled action has deposited in this Court for the defendant the sum of \$1500.00, the amount specified in the Judgment heretofore, to-wit: on the 17th day of April, 1907, made and entered herein, as the value of the land of said defendant taken by said plaintiff; and the further sum of \$21.90, the defendant's costs of suit;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of W. A. Purington, the attorney for the plaintiff,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the land in the plaintiff's Complaint described, and hereinafter more particularly described, become the property of the plaintiff, the City of Riverside, for the purpose of a public park.

The land above referred to is particularly described as follows:

All of that certain fractional lot shown on the Map of Goldsworthy & Higbie, of the lands of the southern California Colony Association, on file in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, lying and being between Lot No. Thirty-three (33), shown on

1 said Map, and the line of the Rubidoux Rancho, containing Two and
2 95/100 (2.95) acres, more or less, subject to the easement
3 thereover for a public street granted by deed to said City of
4 Riverside.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the plaintiff be let into
6 possession of the premises hereinbefore described, and that the
7 Sheriff of the County of Riverside, if requested, shall deliver
8 possession thereof to the plaintiff.
