"Commencing where the north line of Lots 8 and 9 of the subdivision of the lands of the Rubidoux Rancho on the west side of the Santa Ana river intersects the Public Highway leading from Cornelius Jansen's residence to Agua Mansa; thence easterly along said line across the Santa Ana River to the intersection of the road located by the R. L. & I. Co. around the western base of Rubidoux Mountain; said Public Highway being 40 feet wide and to come wholly from lands of parties of first part; and the center of the road is to be 20 feet north of and parallel with said north line of lots 8 and 9. I. V.
