I have in my possession a deed which belongs Dear Str :-in your office, #245, from H. E. McDowell and wife to the City of Riverside, dated July 5th, 1909 and recorded July 17th, 1909, in book of Deeds 288 at page 261, records of Riverside, County, State of California, and said deed is from H. E. McDowell and Belle McDowell his wife of Claycenter, Nebr. to the City of Riverside for the small triangle in the northeast corner of Lot 55 S.C.C.A. lands, which triangle is between the new extension of the North Main St. Rialto road and the property of W.R. Colvin and Maggie Colvin of Carlisle, Ind. and said triangle should have been deeded by said McDowell and wife directly to said Colvin and wife but was inadvertently deeded to the city. By resolution of the City Council at a recent meeting, the Mayor and City Clerk were authorized to redeed this triangle to Mr. Colvin and wife and we have this day signed such a deed and mailed it to Mr. Colvin as shown by letter this day written and copied in the Mayor's copy book at page 178.

In as much as the city will have no further use for said deed #245 and in as much as it properly belongs to said Colvin, I have inclosed deed to him and you will please file this letter among the records in place of said deed #245.
