

GRANT DEED

For and in consideration of the sum of Ten Dollars

Nathan W. Tarr and Helen T. Tarr, his wife,

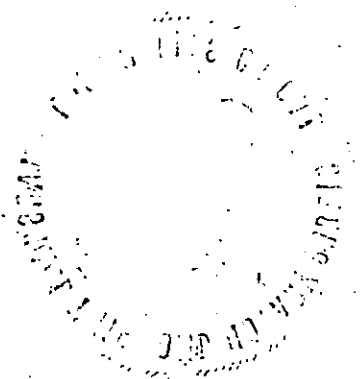
do hereby

GRANT to the City of Riverside, a municipal corporation,

all that real property situated in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

A strip of land Fifty (50) feet wide, across Lots Six (6) and Eleven (11), in Block Twenty-six (26) of the Village of Arlington, as shown by Map recorded in Book 1 page 62 of Maps, records of San Bernardino County, California, described as follows, to-wit:-

Commencing at a point on the Southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue One hundred forty (140) feet Northeasterly from the Northwesterly corner of said Lot 6; running thence Southeasterly and parallel with the Southwesterly line of said Lots 6 and 11, to the Northwesterly line of Hoag Street; thence Northeasterly, along the said Northwesterly line of Hoag Street, Fifty (50) feet; thence at a right angle Northwesterly and parallel with the Southwesterly line of said Lots 6 and 11, to the Southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue; and thence Southwesterly, along the Southeasterly line of Magnolia Avenue, Fifty (50) feet to the point of beginning; said strip of land to be used for a public street.

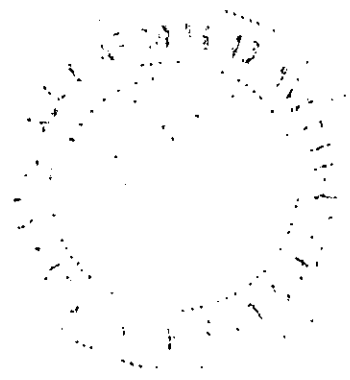
