

THIS INDENTURE, made this 15th day of February 618  
1919, by and between LOS ANGELES & SALT LAKE RAILROAD COMPANY, a  
corporation, organized and existing under and by virtue of the  
laws of the State of Utah, and duly authorized to transact busi-  
ness in the State of California, first party, and CITY OF RIVER-  
SIDE, (a municipal corporation of the State of California),  
second party,

WITNESSETH:

That the said first party hereby grants to the second  
party (subject to the terms and conditions hereinafter set forth,  
and in consideration thereof) an easement for the construction  
and maintenance of a street or highway, upon and across that  
certain parcel of land situate in the City of Riverside, County  
of Riverside, State of California, and bounded and particularly  
described as follows, to wit:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the Northwest  
one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ )  
of Fractional Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 5 West,  
San Bernardino Base and Meridian; thence West on the South  
line of the Northwest one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest  
one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section, 60 feet; thence at  
right angles North 60 feet, thence at right angles East 60  
feet to the East line of the Northwest one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ )  
of the Northwest one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of said Section;  
thence at right angles South on said line, 3.10 feet;  
thence at right angles East 10 feet; thence at right angles  
South 56.9 feet to the south line of the Northeast one-  
quarter ( $N.E.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northwest one-quarter ( $N.W.\frac{1}{4}$ ) of  
said Section; thence West 10 feet on said line to the  
point of beginning.

All of the lands hereinabove referred to and de-  
scribed are shown upon the map hereto attached and approved  
by the Chief Engineer of the first party and made a part  
hereof.

Should the second party at any time abandon said use

of said property, the rights hereby granted shall cease and determine and revert to the first party, its successors or assigns, Mayor, and H. C. Clark, City Clerk,

This easement is subject to the continuing right and obligation of the first party, its successors and assigns, to use and maintain its railroad right of way in the performance of its obligations to the public as common carrier, reserving to the first party and its successors in ownership of said right of way the right to construct, maintain, use and operate existing or additional railroad tracks and appurtenances, telephone, telegraph, signal lines, or other railway facilities, upon, along or across any or all parts of the above described land, and to use the same for railroad purposes; all of such reserved rights to be exercised so as not to prevent the reasonable use of said described premises as a public street or highway.

This instrument is subject to all valid and existing contracts, leases or encumbrances which may affect said property, (including the operation and control of the railroad of said Los Angeles & Salt Lake Railroad Company under the United States Railroad Administration by Walker D. Hines, Director General of Railroads, or his successor), and the word "grant" as used herein shall not be construed as a covenant against the existence of the same or any thereof.
