BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacation shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body dated January 9, 1978,

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION OF INDIANA AVENUE VACATION - VAC-15-778

That portion of Indiana Avenue, 80.00 feet wide, lying between Blocks 45 and 46 of the Lands of the Riverside Land and Irrigating Company as shown by map on file in Book 1 of Maps, at Page 70 thereof, records of Riverside County, California; described as follows:

COMMENCING at the most westerly corner of Lot "A" of Tract 7503-4 as shown by map on file in Book 93 of Maps, at Pages 67 through 69 inclusive, records of Riverside County, California, said corner being on the southeasterly line of said Indiana Avenue;

THENCE South 55° 58' 25" West, along said southeasterly line, a distance of 114.64 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel of land to be described;

THENCE continuing South 55° 58' 25" West, along said southeasterly line, a distance of 733.46 feet to the most northerly corner of that certain parcel of land as conveyed to the City of Riverside by deed recorded July 5, 1977 as Instrument No. 124803, Official Records of Riverside County, California;

THENCE North 05° 28' 40" West, a distance of 7.97 feet to a line parallel with and 7.00 feet northwesterly, measured at right angle from the southeasterly line of said Indiana Avenue;

THENCE North 55° 58' 25" East, along said parallel line, a distance of 310.08 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve;

THENCE Northeasterly along said tangent curve, concave northwesterly, having a radius of 333.00 feet, through a central angle of 38° 40' 02", an arc length of 224.73 feet to the northwesterly line of said Indiana Avenue, also being the southeasterly line of Lot "I" of Tract 6756 as shown by map on file in Book 113 of Maps, at Pages 57 through 60 inclusive, records of Riverside County, California;

THENCE North 55° 58' 25" East, along said northwesterly line of Indiana Avenue, a distance of 29.14 feet to a line concentric with and 55.00 feet southerly, measured radially from the centerline of Indiana Avenue (Lot "G") as shown on said Tract 6756;

THENCE Easterly along said line on a non-tangent curve concave northerly, having a radius of 555.00 feet, through a central angle of 20° 40′ 13″, an arc length of 200.22 feet to said point of beginning (the initial radial line bears South 00° 00′ 18″ East).

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
