ORDINANCE NO. 5192

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 12508; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR GAS, WATER, SEWER LINE AND ELECTRICAL DISTRIBUTION FACILITIES AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF THIRTEENTH STREET; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 4425.

WHEREAS on January 7, 1975, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 12508 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of Thirteenth Street and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941 (now identified as the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law) being Section 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941 (now identified as the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law); and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of Thirteenth Street ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS on July 5, 1977, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Ordinance No. 4425 making its order vacating a portion of Thirteenth Street; and

WHEREAS the legal description of said portion of
Thirteenth Street ordered vacated included reservations of
the fee rather than easements for gas, water, sewer line, and

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electrical distribution facilities; and

WHEREAS the City desires to reserve easements and not the fee, which can be accomplished by repealing Ordinance No. 4425 and incorporating a new legal description in this ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of Thirteenth Street in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

That portion of Thirteenth Street, as shown by map of the Santa Fe Tract, on file in Book 6 of Maps, at page 14 thereof, records of San Bernardino County, California, lying Northwesterly of a line which is parallel with and distant 27 feet Northwesterly, as measured at right angle from the centerline of Howard Avenue, and lying Southeasterly of a line which is parallel with and distant 125 feet Northwesterly, as measured at right angle from said centerline of Howard Avenue.

RESERVING therefrom an easement upon, over, under and across the Southwesterly 10 feet for gas line facilities;

ALSO RESERVING therefrom an easement upon, over, under and across the Southwesterly 1/2 (one-half) for water line facilities;

ALSO RESERVING therefrom an easement upon, over, under and across the Northeasterly 10 feet of the Southwesterly 38 feet for sewer line facilities;

ALSO RESERVING therefrom an easement upon, over, under and across the Northeasterly 1/2 (one-half) for electrical distribution facilities;

be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way for gas line, water line and sewer line purposes and electrical distribution facilities; and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines and sewer lines and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy and water; including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials

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and wood growth that would interfere with the use of said permanent easements and rights of way.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Council does hereby declare that the legal descriptions contained in Resolution No. 12508 and in the Notice of Intention to Vacate a Portion of Thirteenth Street shall be deemed to have been amended by this reference, and Ordinance No. 4425 of the City of Riverside (which was recorded on July 12, 1977 as Instrument No. 130560 and assigned City Deed No. 8994) is hereby repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause publication once in a newspaper of general circulation in accordance with Section 414 of the Charter of the City of Riverside. This ordinance shall become effective on the 30th day after the date of its adoption.
