OF CRANFORD PLACE, AND IDENTIFIED IN EXHIBIT A OF RESOLUTION NO. 14627 AS PARCEL 2.

WHEREAS on February 23, 1982, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 14627 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of Seventh Street right-of-way and contiguous alley approximately 500 feet easterly of Chicago Avenue and westerly of Cranford Place, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of the alley ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of the alley in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, identified as Parcel 2 in Exhibit A of Resolution No. 14627, and more particularly described in the document attached hereto,

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marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way for sewer, storm drain, and water line facilities, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of sewer and storm drain facilities and for the transportation or distribution of water; including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth that would interfere with the use of said permanent easements and rights of way.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the vacation shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body dated October 27, 1981, and on file with the City Clerk have been satisfied; and the City Clerk is hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until the applicable conditions have been satisfied.


THENCE South 89° 47' 51" East, along said south line, 298.58 feet to the east line of said parcel conveyed to City of Riverside;
