WHEREAS on December 4, 1990, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 17635 declaring its 10

intention to order the vacation of a portion of an approximately 11

30-foot-wide unimproved portion of Old Muirfield Road, a 1911

Act easement, situated at the easterly end of Talcey Terrace

extending approximately 1,160 feet to the east, bisecting

Overlook Parkway (extended), and fixing the time and place of

hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation,

pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and

Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of

Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State

> WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

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WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the

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evidence submitted that the portion of Old Muirfield Road ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of Old Muirfield Road in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way for water line, electric energy facilities, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures, as may be applicable, for the operation of water lines and for the transportation or distribution of electric energy; and a permanent easement and right of way to construct, place, operate, inspect, maintain, repair, replace and remove such aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication structures as the Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company may from time to time require consisting of poles, anchors, wires, cables, conduits, manholes, markers and necessary fixtures and appurtenances; including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth that would interfere with the use of said permanent easements and

rights of way.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

VAC-2-901 - Vacation of a portion of Old Muirfield Road extending easterly from Talcey Terrace

That portion of the north half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 12, Township 3 South, Range 5 West, San Bernardino Meridian, described as follows:

That portion of Parcel III of Document recorded January 9, 1959, as Instrument No. 2050 of Official Records of Riverside County, California, being a strip of land 30.00 feet in width, lying 15.00 feet on each side of the following described centerline:

COMMENCING at the southwest corner of said Section 12:

THENCE North 0°16'03" West, along the west line of said Section, a distance of 1283.55 feet to the centerline of said Parcel III;

THENCE North 81°15'26" East, along said centerline, a distance of 419.71 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING; said point being in a nontangent curve concaving southwesterly and having a radius of 73.00 feet; a radial line to said point bears North 63°43'09" East;

THENCE continuing North 81°15'26" East, along said centerline, a distance of 384.39 feet to an angle point therein;

THENCE South 88°28'48" East, continuing along said centerline, a distance of 206.17 feet to an angle point therein;

THENCE North 73°38'18" East, continuing along said centerline, a distance of 437.50 feet to an angle point therein;

THENCE South 85.25'00" East, continuing along said centerline, a distance of 133.28 feet to the END of this centerline description;

The sidelines of said 30.00 foot strip shall be lengthened or shortened as to terminate westerly in said nontangent curve and easterly in a line bearing North 0°03'34" East through the end point of said centerline;

EXCEPTING therefrom that portion of said 30.00 foot strip lying 15.00 feet on each side of the following described portion of said centerline;

EXHIBIT A

COMMENCING at the easterly terminus of that certain course described above as "THENCE South 88'28'48" East, continuing along said centerline, a distance of 206.17 feet to an angle point therein";

THENCE North 73°38'18" East, along said centerline, a distance of 21.77 feet to the Point of Beginning;

THENCE continuing North 73°38'18" East, along said centerline, a distance of 155.06 feet to the END of this centerline description;


The sidelines of said strip shall be lengthened or shortened as to terminate northeasterly in a line which bears North 59°02'20" West through the end of said centerline and southwesterly in a line which bears North 59°02'20" West through said Point of Beginning;

RESERVING therefrom a permanent easement and right of way for electrical energy distribution facilities;

ALSO RESERVING therefrom a permanent easement and right of way for waterline facilities;

ALSO RESERVING therefrom a permanent easement and right of way for aerial and underground telephone, telegraph, and communication facilities.
