TEMPORARY CONSTRUCTION EASEMENT

FOR VALUABLE CONSIDERATION, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, CPI DEVELOPMENT, INC., a California corporation, as Grantor, grants to the CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation of the State of California, as Grantee, its successors and assigns, a temporary easement and right-of-way for the construction and installation of slopes and storm drain facilities, together with all necessary appurtenances, in, under, upon, over and along that certain real property as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference, located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California.
