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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 17306; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SANITARY SEWER AND GAS LINE FACILITIES AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CON-VENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING VISTA STREET, SITUATED EASTERLY OF ORANGE STREET AND NORTHERLY OF THE 60 POMONA FREEWAY.

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WHEREAS on October 24, 1989, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 17306 declaring its intention to order the vacation of Vista Street, situated easterly of Orange Street and northerly of the 60 Pomona Freeway, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the street ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that Vista Street in the

## LEGAL DESCRIPTION VAC-19-889 - Vacation of Vista Street located easterly of Orange Street and northerly of Freeway Route 60

Those portions of Lots 20 through 23, inclusive, Arroyo Vista Avenue, Flower Street, and the Riverside Water Company's Lower Canal as shown by map of Files Subdivision No. 4, on file in Book 6, Page 60 of Maps, records of Riverside County, California, together with that portion of Lot 53 of the Lands of the Southern California Colony Association, as shown by map on file in Book 7, Page 3 of Maps, records of San Bernardino County, California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the most southerly corner of said Flower Street; said corner also being the most easterly corner of Lot 30 of said Files Subdivision No. 4:

THENCE North  $60^{\circ}$  13' 10" West, along the southwesterly line of said Flower Street, a distance of 300.05 feet to an angle point therein;

THENCE continuing along said southwesterly line, North 43° 00' 56" West, a distance of 52.35 feet to the most easterly corner of said Lot 23;

THENCE leaving said southwesterly line, North 56° 43' 53" West, a distance of 60.02 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concaving southerly and having a radius of 270.00 feet;

THENCE westerly along said curve through a central angle of 17° 31' 38", an arc length of 82.60 feet;

THENCE North 74° 15' 31" West, a distance of 59.75 feet to a point in the northerly line of State Route 60, as shown by Sheet 17 of 26 sheets of State Highway Right-of-Way Map VIII Riv 19 Riv, on file with the County Surveyor of said Riverside County;

THENCE continuing North 74° 15' 31" West, along said northerly line, a distance of 79.16 feet to a point in a line parallel with and distant 35.00 feet southeasterly, as measured at right angles from the centerline of Orange Street as shown on said State Highway Right-of-Way Map;

THENCE North 29° 45' 50" East, along said parallel line, a distance of 67.63 feet to the beginning of a non-tangent curve concaving northeasterly and having a radius of 20.00 feet; a radial line to said beginning bears South 59° 45' 50" West;

THENCE southeasterly along said non-tangent curve through a central angle of 44° 01' 21", an arc length of 15.37 feet:

THENCE South 74° 15' 31" East, a distance of 108.62 feet to the beginning of a tangent curve concaving southerly and having a radius of 330.00 feet;

THENCE easterly along said last mentioned curve through a central angle of 13° 39' 53", an arc length of 78.70 feet;

THENCE South 68° 26' 56" East, a distance of 16.14 feet to the beginning of a non-tangent curve concaving northerly and having a radius of 93.31 feet; a radial line to said beginning bears South 21° 06' 50" West;

THENCE easterly along said last mentioned curve through a central angle of  $2^{\circ}$  01' 37", an arc length of 3.30 feet;

THENCE South 43° 39' 34" East, a distance of 114.00 feet to an angle point in the northeasterly line of said Flower Street;

THENCE South 60° 13' 10" East, along said northeasterly line, a distance of 300.05 feet to the most easterly corner of said Flower Street;

THENCE South 29° 46' 55" West, along the southeasterly line of said Flower Street, a distance of 50.00 feet to the POINT OF BEGINNING.

RESERVING THEREFROM a permanent easement and right-of-way for gasline facilities;

ALSO RESERVING THEREFROM a permanent easement and right-of-way for sanitary sewer facilities.
