A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 18063; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR GAS LINE FACILITIES, FOR AERIAL AND UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND COMMUNICATION FACILITIES AND FOR ELECTRIC ENERGY AND WATER FACILITIES, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A ROAD EASEMENT EXTENDING NORTHERLY FROM OVERLOOK PARKWAY AND A PORTION OF MUIRFIELD ROAD SITUATED NORTHERLY OF OVERLOOK PARKWAY; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 18080.

#### RESOLUTION NO. 18981

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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 18063; RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR GAS LINE FACILITIES, FOR AERIAL AND UNDERGROUND TELEPHONE, TELEGRAPH AND COMMUNICATION FACILITIES AND FOR ELECTRIC ENERGY AND WATER FACILITIES, AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE THE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A ROAD EASEMENT EXTENDING NORTHERLY FROM OVERLOOK PARKWAY AND A PORTION OF MUIRFIELD ROAD SITUATED NORTHERLY OF OVERLOOK PARKWAY; AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 18080.

WHEREAS on August 18, 1992, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 18063 declaring its intention in Vacation Case VAC-8-912 to order the vacation of various road easements and portions of Muirfield Road located within Tentative Tract 26109, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Section 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation had been previously submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside at a duly noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS following the close of the public hearing before the Planning Commission, the Planning Commission approved Vacation Case VAC-8-912 subject to all staff conditions and determined that the proposed project would not have a significant adverse affect on the environment; and

WHEREAS notice of hearing before the City Council of said

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 resolution of intention was given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS the recommendations of the Planning Commission were duly transmitted to the City Council and were considered by the City Council together with the testimony, whether oral or in writing, presented at the duly noticed public hearing before said City Council; and

WHEREAS the City Council heard and found and determined from all of the evidence submitted to said Council on the day fixed for the hearing that the road easements and portions of Muirfield Road located within Tentative Tract 26109 ordered vacated were unnecessary for present or prospective public use; and

WHEREAS on September 15, 1992, the City Council adopted three resolutions, including Resolution No. 18080, making its findings and determinations in the matter of Resolution of Intention No. 18063 including findings and determinations regarding the reservations of easements and ordering the vacation of various road easements and portions of Muirfield Road to reflect the proposed phasing plan for Tentative Tract No. 26109, ordering that the vacation occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body and on file with the City Clerk have been satisfied, and directing the City Clerk to not record the resolutions of vacation until the applicable conditions had been satisfied; and

WHEREAS the phasing plan for Tentative Tract No. 26109

has been changed and it would be appropriate to amend the descriptions of the roadway easements and portions of Muirfield Road in each of the three previously adopted resolutions to reflect the new phasing plan and the determinations regarding reservations of easements for each such segment of roadway easement or Muirfield Road to be vacated in each phase;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: That the vacation of the hereinafter described portion of a 60-foot-wide roadway easement extending northerly from Overlook Parkway approximately 165 feet and the hereinafter described portion of the approximately twenty-five to thirty-foot wide by nine hundred foot long unimproved portion of Muirfield Road in the City of Riverside is undertaken pursuant to the provisions of and in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law and that all notices required thereby have been duly given.

Section 2: That from all of the evidence submitted to the City Council at the public hearing before it on Vacation Case VAC-8-912, whether such evidence was oral or in writing, together with the recommendations from the Planning Commission, that portion of a 60-foot-wide roadway easement extending northerly from Overlook Parkway approximately 165 feet and that portion of the approximately twenty-five to thirty-foot wide by nine hundred foot long unimproved portion of Muirfield Road as hereinafter described and ordered vacated are unnecessary for present or prospective public use as a public street.

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That the proposed project will not have a significant adverse effect on the environment and adopts a Negative Declaration.

Section 4: That portion of a 60-foot-wide road easement extending northerly from Overlook Parkway approximately 165 feet and that portion of the approximately twenty-five to thirty-foot wide by nine hundred foot long unimproved portion of Muirfield Road in the City of Riverside described in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A", and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same are hereby ordered vacated.

<u>Section 5</u>: That the public convenience and necessity require the exception from the vacation of those easements and rights-of-way over, along and across portions of the roadway easements and unimproved street ordered to be vacated as more particularly described as Parcels 2 and 3 in Exhibit "A" necessary for gas line facilities, aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication facilities and electrical energy distribution facilities and waterline facilities, and the reservation of the following: (a) an easement for and the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles, and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas line facilities; (b) an easement for and the right to construct, place, operate, inspect, maintain, repair, replace and remove aerial and underground telephone, telegraph and communication structures as may from time to time be required consisting of poles, anchors, wires, cables, conduits, manholes,

markers and necessary fixtures and appurtenances; and (c) an easement for and the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew, and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the distribution of electric energy and water.

Section 6: That the vacation, termination and abandonment of that portion of a 60-foot-wide road easement extending northerly from Overlook Parkway approximately 165 feet and that portion of the approximately twenty-five to thirty-foot wide by nine hundred foot long unimproved portion of Muirfield Road described in Exhibit "A" shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative body and on file with the City Clerk as approved by the City Council have been satisfied, and the City Clerk is hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until the applicable conditions have been satisfied.

Section 7: That the City Clerk of the City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California, upon the satisfaction of the applicable conditions, and that portion of a 60-foot-wide road easement extending northerly from Overlook Parkway approximately 165 feet and that portion of the approximately twenty-five to thirty-foot wide by nine hundred foot long unimproved portion of Muirfield Road described in Exhibit "A" shall no longer constitute a portion of a public street from and after said date of recordation.

Section 8: Resolution No. 18080 is hereby repealed.


