A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE SUMMARY VACATION OF TWO LETTERED REMNANT LOTS OF ADAMS STREET EXTENSION RIGHT-OF-WAY, LOCATED NORTH OF ARLINGTON AVENUE AND RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE FLIGHT AND PASSAGE OF AIRCRAFT, AND FOR STORM DRAIN AND PUBLIC UTILITY PURPOSES.

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RESOLUTION NO. 19413

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, PROVIDING FOR THE SUMMARY VACATION OF TWO LETTERED REMNANT LOTS OF ADAMS STREET EXTENSION RIGHT-OF WAY, LOCATED NORTH OF ARLINGTON AVENUE AND RESERVING PERMANENT EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY FOR THE FLIGHT AND PASSAGE OF AIRCRAFT, AND FOR STORM DRAIN AND PUBLIC UTILITY PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, two lettered remnant lots of Adams Street extension right-of way, north of Arlington Avenue which were dedicated to the City for street purposes when the adjacent residential subdivisions to the east were developed, are no longer required for street purposes and now constitute excess right of way and surplus property; and

WHEREAS, the extension of Adams Street was removed from the City's General Plan Circulation Element in 1994; and

WHEREAS, applicant wishes to vacate the remnant rights-of-way with the vacated area to be disposed of by operation of law between Harvest Christian Fellowship church to the west and the adjacent residential property owners to the east; and

WHEREAS, notices regarding the proposed vacation have been sent to all affected parties and agencies and no negative responses have been received; and

WHEREAS, Section 8330 et seq, of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California provide for the summary vacation of streets and public service easements under certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, Section 8334 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate an excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to proceed under the provisions of Sections 8330 et seq. of the Streets and Highways Code to summarily vacate the hereinafter described two lettered remnant lots of Adams Street Extension right-of-way northerly of Arlington Avenue and to reserve easements for the flight and passage of aircraft, and for storm drain and public utility purposes as hereinafter described.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: The vacation of the two lettered remnant lots of Adams Street extension right-of-way to the north of Arlington Avenue ("remnant lots") as more particularly described in Exhibit A and Exhibit B, which exhibits are attached hereto and made a part hereof by this reference, is being undertaken pursuant to, and in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 4, commencing with Section 8330 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

Section 2: The City Council finds and determines that the remnant lots constitute surplus property and excess right-of-way of a street which are not required for street or highway purposes.

Section 3: The City Council finds and determines that access to adjoining properties will not be affected.

Section 4: The City Council finds and determines that this portion of the street has been closed and impassable as a public roadway and no public funds have been expended on its maintenance for the last five years.

Section 5: The City Council formally recognizes that the proposed project consisting of surplus property is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to Section 15312 of the state CEQA Guidelines (Title 14 California Administrative Code, Section 15312).

Section 6: That the public convenience and necessity requires the exception from the vacation hereinabove ordered of those easements and rights of way as more particularly described in said Exhibits A and B over, along, and across said remnant lettered lots ordered to be vacated necessary for public utility and storm drain facilities, and the right of flight and passage of aircraft.

Section 7: The City Council hereby orders the summary vacation of the two remnant lots described in Exhibit A and Exhibit B.

Section 8: The City Clerk of the City of Riverside shall, upon receiving notification to record the resolution by the City's Surveyor, cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California and the street right-of-way

described in Exhibit A and Exhibit B shall be and is hereby terminated as of the date of said 2 recordation and shall no longer constitute a street from and after said date of recordation. 


