A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF 19227; RESERVING A PERMANENT INTENTION NO. EASEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR PUBLIC UTILITIES THE THAT PUBLIC PURPOSES AND DETERMINING CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REOUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENT; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING THE APPROXIMATELY 20-FOOT WIDE 319.5-FOOT LONG ALLEY EXTENDING FROM TO TWELFTH ELEVENTH STREET STREET SITUATED BETWEEN MARKET STREET AND MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, on February 3, 1998, the City Council of the City of Riverside in Vacation Case No. VC-003-978 adopted Resolution No. 19227 declaring its intention to order the vacation of the approximately 20-foot wide by 319.5-foot long alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street within the City of Riverside, California, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation pursuant to the provisions of the Public Streets, Highways and Service Easements Vacation Law, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation had been previously submitted to and considered by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside at a duly noticed public hearing; and

WHEREAS, following the close of the public hearing before the Planning Commission, the Planning Commission determined that the proposed project would not have a significant adverse affect on the environment and that the City Council should adopt a Negative Declaration, and that Vacation Case VC-003-978 should be

approved subject to all staff conditions; and

WHEREAS, notice of hearing before the City Council on said resolution of intention was duly given as provided by said Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law; and

WHEREAS the recommendations of the Planning Commission were submitted to the City Council for consideration together with the testimony, whether oral or in writing, presented at the public hearing before said City Council; and

WHEREAS the City Council heard and found and determined from all of the evidence submitted to said Council on the day fixed for the hearing that the approximately 20-foot wide by 319.5-foot alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street was unnecessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, FOUND AND DETERMINED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, as follows:

Section 1: That the vacation of the approximately 20foot wide by 319.5-foot wide alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street in the City of Riverside in Vacation Case VC-003-978 is undertaken pursuant to the provisions of and in accordance with the procedures set forth in the Public Streets, Highways, and Service Easements Vacation Law and that all notices required thereby have been duly given.

That from all of the evidence submitted to Section 2: the City Council at the public hearing before it on Vacation Case VC-003-978, whether such evidence was oral or in writing,

together with the recommendations from the Planning Commission, the approximately 20-foot wide by 319.5-foot alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street within the City of Riverside as hereinafter described and ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use as an alley.

That the proposed project will not have a Section 3: significant adverse effect on the environment and adopts a Negative Declaration.

Section 4: That the approximately 20-foot wide by 319.5foot long alley situated between Market Street and Main Street situated between Market Street and Main Street within the City of Riverside, California and described in the document attached hereto, marked Exhibit A, and by this reference made a part hereof, be and the same is hereby ordered vacated subject to the reservation of easements as hereinafter set forth.

That the public convenience and necessity Section 5: requires the exception from the vacation hereinabove ordered of an easement and right-of-way for public utilities purposes over, under, along and across said 20-foot wide by 319.5 foot alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street ordered to be vacated.

Section 6: That the vacation, termination abandonment of the alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street described in Exhibit A shall occur only after the applicable conditions contained in the Planning Department's report to the legislative

body and on file with the City Clerk as approved or amended by the City Council have been satisfied, and the City Clerk is hereby directed not to record this resolution of vacation until the applicable conditions have been satisfied.

<u>Section 7</u>: That the City Clerk of the City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this resolution to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California, upon the satisfaction of the applicable conditions, and the alley extending from Eleventh Street to Twelfth Street situated between Market Street and Main Street described in Exhibit A shall no longer constitute a public alley from and after said date of recordation.


