

Adjourned regular meeting of the Mayor and Common Council of the City
of Riverside held on Tuesday, April 7, 1925, at 9:00 o'clock A.M.

Present: Mayor Evans presiding; Councilmen Strickler, Winship, Wagner,
Taylor and Jarvis; Clerk Burns.

It was moved by Councilman Winship, seconded by Councilman Strickler,
that the following resolution be adopted:

RESOLUTION NO. 758 (NEW SERIES)

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did, on the 27th day
of January, 1925, pass its Resolution of Intention No. 738 (New Series) to order
the hereinafter described work to be done, which said resolution of intention was
duly and legally published as required by law, as appears from the affidavit of
H. W. Hammond, now on file in the office of the Clerk of said city; and

WHEREAS, notices of the passage of said resolution, headed "Notice of
Public Works," were duly and legally posted along the line of said contemplated
work or improvement in form and manner as required by law, as appears from the
affidavit of C. M. Gruwell, who posted the same, now on file in the office of the
Clerk of said city, and showing that said posting was completed on the 31st day
of January, 1925; and

WHEREAS, all protests or objections presented have been disposed of in
time, form and manner as required by law, and said Common Council has now
acquired jurisdiction to order the proposed work; and

WHEREAS, said proposed work is for closing up a portion of North Harrison
Street, and it appears to said Common Council that no assessment is necessary,

IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Common Council of the City of Riverside
that the public interest and convenience require, and the said Common Council
hereby orders to be done, the work of closing up and vacating a portion of North
Harrison Street in said city, described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of North Harrison Street lying between the northerly line
of Magnolia Avenue and a line drawn parallel with and distant 17 feet westerly,

measured at right angles, from the easterly line of Lot 39, Village of Arlington, as recorded in Book 1 of Maps, page 62, Records of San Bernardino County, California,

in accordance with said resolution of intention, declaring the intention of said Common Council to order said work to be done, and it is hereby ordered that said work be done in accordance with said resolution of intention.

This motion carried by the following vote:
