A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ENVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 9192 ; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGH RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A WALKWAY IN WESTERN HOMES TRACT.

WHEREAS, on August 1, 1961, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9192 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a walkway in Western Homes Tract, and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the said walkway hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said walkway in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

> A strip of land 10.0 feet in width, being all of Lot "F" of Western Homes Tract as shown on map on file in Book 24, page 17 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California;

RESERVING an easement for drainage purposes over the south 10.0 feet of the above said Lot "F", be and the same is hereby vacated.

hereby determine that the rublic convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across the walkway to be vacated, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, water and incidental purposes including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the said walkway to be vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City


