RESOLUTION NO. 9605

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING CERTAIN LAND OFFERED FOR DEDICATION TO PUBLIC USE

AS A PART OF OAK CREST DRIVE.

WHEREAS, on November 27, 1962, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 9568 declaring its intention to order the vacation of certain land offered for dedication to public use as a part of Oak Crest Drive and fixing the time and place for hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Section 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council, heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the land hereinafter ordered vacated is unnecessary for present and prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the certain land offered for dedication to public use as a part of Oak Crest Drive situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

> All of the property and rights offered for dedication to public use by Instrument No. 59003 recorded June 25, 1962, Records of Riverside County, California, described as follows:

Parcel 1

That portion of the South-half of Section 36, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, S.B.B.& M., more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of Lot 21 of Tract No. 2109 as shown by map on file in Book 44 of Maps, at pages 27 and 28 thereof, records of River-

side County, California;

Thence South 27° 08' East along the westerly
line of Oak Crest Drive (Lot C) as shown on said map
of Tract No. 2109, a distance of 36.86 feet to an

angle point in the westerly line of said Oak Crest Drive (Lot C) for the true point of beginning, said point being on a curve concave to the northeast having a radius of 45.00 feet, from which the center of said curve bears North 89° 20' East;

Thence southerly and easterly along said curve to the left through a central angle of 126° 52! 12" an arc distance of 99.65 feet to a point of reverse curvature with a curve concave to the southeast, having a radius of 15.00 feet, the radial line at said point bears South 37° 32' 12" East;

Thence easterly along said last mentioned curve to the right through a central angle of 36' 52' 12" an

arc distance of 9.65 feet to the end thereof;

Thence North 89° 20' East and parallel with the south line of said Oak Crest Drive (Lot C) a distance of 203.67 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 1 of said Tract No. 2109;

Thence North 00° 36' 50" West along the boundary line of said Oak Crest Drive (Lot C) a distance of 33.00 feet to an angle point therein;

Thence South 89° 20' West along the boundary line of said Oak Crest Drive (Lot C) a distance of 284.70 feet to the true point of beginning

Parcel 2

All that portion of Lot 21 of Tract No. 2109 as shown by map on file in Book 44 of Maps, at pages 27, 28 thereof, Records of Riverside County, California, more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the southwest corner of said Lot 21;
Thence North 89° 20' East along the south line
of said Lot 21 a distance of 30.84 feet to a point
thereon for the true point of beginning, said point being on a curve concave to the southeast having a radius of 45.00 feet, from which the center of said curve bears South 43° 30' East;

Thence easterly along said curve to the right, through a central angle of 79° 42' 12' an arc distance of 62.61 feet to a point of reverse curvature with a curve concave to the north having a radius of 15.00 feet, the radial line at said point bears North 36° 12' East; East;

Thence easterly along said last mentioned curve to the left, through a central angle of 36° 52'12" as arc distance of 9.65 feet to a point on said south line of Lot 21 distant thereon South 89° 20' West 34.59 feet from the southeast corner of said Lot 21; Thence South 89° 20' West along said south line

a distance of 66.59 feet to the true point of beginning,

is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that the same be and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded
