PETITION TO CHANGE PORTION OF PEPPER DRIVE, LA SIERRA HEIGHTS,
 TO LINN DRIVE & CAMPUS DRIVE GRANTED, AS RECOMMENDED BY RIVER-
 SIDE COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION.

IT WAS ORDERED that said recommendation be, and the same is hereby approved, and that the following described portion of the road named Pepper Drive by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County ^{For this resolution See R.A. 9306} made February 10, 1941, be named and known as Linn Drive, beginning at the intersection of Pepper Drive and Linn Drive, as shown on a map of La Sierra Vista Tract, filed in Map Book 12, at page 69, in the office of the Recorder of Riverside County, California; thence southerly, following the present traveled road through Lots 20 and 24, as shown on Assessor's Map No. 20, filed in Book 1 of Assessor's Maps, at pages 24 and 25 thereof, ~~filed~~ in the office of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, a distance of 875 feet to a point where said traveled road makes an abrupt turn to the East;

ALSO, the following described portion of the road named Pepper Drive by resolution of the Board of Supervisors of Riverside County, California, ^{R.A. 9306} made February 10, 1941, be named and known as Campus Drive, being at the intersection of Pierce Place and Sierra Vista Avenue; thence southwesterly on the continuation of Pierce Place, and along the road - 60 feet in width, as shown on Assessor's Map No. 20, filed in Book 1 of Assessor's Map, at pages 24 and 25 thereof, records of the Recorder of Riverside County, California, lying southerly of, and adjoining Lots 20 and 21-B, as shown on said Map and following the traveled road through Lot 24, as shown on said Map, to a point on Linn Drive, as described in this petition, which is 875 feet southerly from its intersection with Pepper Drive.
