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A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO.10616; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING A PORTION OF GAGE STREET.

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WHEREAS on August 23, 1966, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 10616 declaring its intention to order the vacation of a portion of Gage Street and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council. heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the portion of Gage Street ordered vacated is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the said portion of said street in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

> All that portion of Gage Street (formerly Norton Street) of Tract No. 4 of the Riverview Addition to the City of Riverside as shown by map on file in Book 7, page 6 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California, more particularly described as follows:

> Commencing at the center line intersection of said Gage Street with the center line of Dales Street (formerly Ivy Street) as shown on said map;

Request of City Clerk for recordation of this instrument, and return to City Clerk, Room 10, City Hall, Riverside, California

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Thence South 56° 17' 26" East a distance of 45.00 feet to a point on the southerly right of way line of said Gage Street for the true point of beginning, said point being on a curve concave to the west, having a radius of 45.00 feet, from which the center of said curve bears North 56° 17' 26" West;

Thence northerly along said curve to the left, through a central angle of 67' 29' 50" an arc distance

of 53.01 feet to a point on the northerly right of way line of said Gage Street, from which the center of said curve bears South 56° 12' 44" West;

Thence North 89° 57' 39" East along said northerly right of way line, a distance of 139.57 feet to an intersection with the southeasterly right of way line of that certain railroad right of way 50.00 feet in of that certain railroad right of way, 50.00 feet in width as shown by Record of Survey on file in Book

19, pages 68 through 70 of Records of Survey, Records of Riverside County;

Thence South 36° 38' 29" West, along said southeasterly right of way line, a distance of 62.35 feet to a point in said southerly right of way line of Gage Street;

Thence South 89° 57' 39" West along said southerly right of way line a distance of 102.33 feet to the true point of beginning.

RESERVING THEREFROM for public utility purposes the northerly 20 feet of the southerly half of said street to be vacated, as measured at right angles to the center line of said street,

be and the same is hereby vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby determine that the public convenience and necessity require the reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers and storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across the above described portion of the street to be vacated, and reserving the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace remove, renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, poles and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines, and for the transportation and distribution of electric energy, petroleum and its products, water and incidental purposes, including access and the right to keep the property free from inflammable materials and wood growth and otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the above described portion of Gage Street to be vacated.

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IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested by the City Clerk under the seal of said City to be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.


