RESOLUTION NO. 10866

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING EASEMENT RIGHTS IN PORTIONS OF LOT 314 OF THE LANDS OF THE SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA COLONY ASSOCIATION.

WHEREAS it appears that the City of Riverside has excepted and reserved the right of entry upon and right of way over and through the hereinafter described property for the construction and maintenance of all water ditches, pipe lines, flumes, conduits and reservoirs for the conveyance and storing of all water for irrigating and domestic use, which reservation and exception is set forth in that certain deed from City of Riverside to Huntington Park Association, dated June 23, 1914, and recorded January 28, 1915, in Book No. 411 of Deeds, page 90 et seq., Records of Riverside County, California; and

WHEREAS it appears that said excepted and reserved rights, hereinafter called easements rights, are no longer necessary for present or prospective public use;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that said easement rights be and the same are hereby vacated, said easement rights being upon and over that certain property situated in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

Those portions of Lot 314 of the Lands of the Southern California Colony Association, as shown by map on file in Book 4, page 75 of Maps, Riverside County Records, situated in the Hotel Tract, as provided for by paragraph 3 of Contracts of May 4, 1887 between the Riverside Land Company, E. Rosenthal, Riverside Water Company and Riverside Land and Irrigating Company, which portions of said Hotel Tract are described as follows:

PARCEL 1:

Beginning at a point which bears South 66° 50' West, 247.17 feet from the intersection of the center lines of Rubidoux Drive and Ninth Street as shown by map of Mount Rubidoux Park on file in Book 19, page 65 of Maps, Riverside County Records;

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Thence South 09° 20' West 111.70 feet; Thence South 12° 46' East 90.41 feet; Thence South 64° 21' East 139.90 feet to the outside edge of the top of the southerly end of a rock wall;

Thence along said edge of said rock wall, on a curve concave to the northwest, having a radius of 43.5 feet, the chord of which bears North 39° 45' East, a distance of 49.32 feet;

Thence North 07° 16' East, along said edge of

said rock wall, 71.5 feet;

Thence along said edge of said rock wall, on a curve to the left, concave to the southwest, having a radius of 48 feet and a central angle of 67° 40', a distance of 56.69 feet;
Thence North 60° 24' West along said edge of

said rock wall, 92.5 feet;

Thence along said edge of said rock wall, on a curve to the right, concave to the northeast, havi a radius of 83 feet and a central angle of 50° 24' having a distance of 73.01 feet, to the northerly end of the rock wall;

Thence North 87° 43' West 22 feet to the point

of beginning.

Said property is also shown on Map of Lot 314 of the Lands of the Riverside Land and Irrigating Company on file in Book 5, page 142 of Maps, Riverside County

EXCEPTING THEREFROM any portion included within Lot "A" of Mount Rubidoux Park Tract No.3, as shown by map on file in Book 19, page 97 of Maps, Riverside County Records;

PARCEL 2:

Beginning at the most southerly corner of that certain parcel of land conveyed to M. E. Pangle et al by deed recorded March 17, 1941, in Book 493, page

314 of Official Records, Riverside County Records; Thence North 60° 24' West 46.30 feet to a point on the northeasterly line of that parcel conveyed to Harold W. Naeckel and Mary Coleman Naeckel by deed recorded January 14, 1941, in Book 488, page 110 of Official Records, Riverside County Records;

Thence southeasterly, on a reverse curve concave to the southwest, with a radius of 48 feet and a central angle of 67° 40', a distance of 56.69 feet; the radial line at the beginning of said curve bearing South 29° 36' West;

Thence South 07° 16' West 71.5 feet;

Thence southwesterly on a curve concave to the northwest, with * radius of 43.5 feet and a central angle of 64° 58', a distance of 49.32 feet, the last three courses and distances following along the easterly line of the parcel so conveyed to Harold W. Naeckel and Mary Coleman Naeckel;

Thence South 64° 21' East to a point on the center line of Rubidoux Drive, as shown by map of Mt. Rubidoux Park on file in Book 19, page 65 of Maps, Riverside County Records;

Thence northerly, along the center line of said Rubidoux Drive, to a point which bears South 60° 24' 1 2 3

·East from the point of beginning; Thence North 60° 24' West to the point of beginning: EXCEPTING THEREFROM a right of way for road purposes over the easterly 15 feet in said
