ORDINANCE NO. 3543

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 11019; RESERVING PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING WALKWAYS BETWEEN VANCE STREET AND DOYLE STREET.

WHEREAS on May 28, 1968, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 11019 declaring its intention to order vacation of walkways between Vance Street and Doyle Street and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS said proposed vacation was submitted to and acted upon by the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside and notice of hearing said resolution was given as provided by said Street Vacation Act of 1941; and

WHEREAS on the day fixed for the hearing the City Council heard and considered the evidence offered by persons interested and found and hereby finds from all of the evidence submitted that the walkways ordered vacated are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Riverside does ordain that the said walkways in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

Lots D, E and F of Harmony-Dale Tract as shown by map on file in Book 27, pages 59 and 60 of Maps, Records of Riverside County, California;

RESERVING from said Lot D an easement over the southwesterly 10.00 feet for public utility purposes;

ALSO RESERVING from said Lot E an easement over the northeasterly 10.00 feet of the south-westerly 137.00 feet for public utility purposes;

ALSO RESERVING from said Lot F an easement over the northeasterly 10.00 feet for public utility purposes,

be and the same are hereby vacated.
