A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 11286; RESERVING PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENTS AND DETERMINING THAT THE PUBLIC CON-RESERVING PUBLIC UTILITY VENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE RESERVATION OF SUCH EASEMENTS; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING LOT C (EVERGREEN WAY) AND LOT D (KENSINGTON WAY) IN TRACT 3081.

WHEREAS on July , 1969, the City Council of the City of Riverside adopted Resolution No. 11286 declaring its intention to order the vacation of Lot C (Evergreen Way) and Lot D (Kensington Way) in Tract 3081 and fixing the time and place of hearing all persons interested in the proposed vacation, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Sections 8300 et seq. of Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and
